In order to be nominated as a Delegate at this meeting, a potential nominee must submit a **Petition for Nomination** signed by a minimum of 25 AFSCME members in good standing. This petition is available on the AFSCME website at [www.afscme1624.org](http://www.afscme1624.org) or by calling the office at 512-477-5544. If you need to verify that a petition-signer is a member in good standing, contact the office.

The petition must either be a) **hand-delivered** to the AFSCME office prior to April 22<sup>nd</sup> or b) brought to the meeting on the evening of the Nominations and Elections by **no later than 6pm on April 22<sup>nd</sup>**. The petition is for nomination purposes only. Nominees must be elected by a vote of AFSCME members present at the meeting. Nominees need **not** be present to be elected.

AFSCME Local 1624 will pay expenses for air travel, hotel accommodations and per diem for participants at the Convention. **You must use your own leave time to attend June 28<sup>th</sup> through July 2<sup>nd</sup>.**
